- 1. **City of Hampton**: Terri McCann, Business Development Manager for the City of Hampton, attended the meeting and together with Senior Business Development Manager, Ellen Templeton, provided the following news and information highlights about local area developments:
  - IBEX Global is a call center business located in the Gateway building, employing approximately 700 employees.
  - Medical manufacturing is increasing in the area.

  - Business development focus areas include: Communications, Sensors, IT, and call centers.
  - Due diligence by the "small package sort facility" is ongoing and is now anticipated to close in June 2014.
